for honorary member

SERBIAN ACADEMY OF NONLINEAR SCIENCES

Dr. Katica R. (Stevanović) Hedrih, Doctor of Technical Sciences, with the title of full professor of the university, is an academician of the Academy of Sciences of Higher Schools (and Universities) of Ukraine, the National Academy of Sciences of Higher Education (postgraduate) of Ukraine and the International Academy of Nonlinear Sciences in Moscow.

He is one of the ten founders of the Branch of the Academy of Nonlinear Sciences from Moscow, in Belgrade,

and one of the first three elected academicians of the Academy of Nonlinear Sciences (ANN) in Moscow in 1997, on the initiative and proposal of the academician, president and founder of ANN Vladimir Metodijević Matrosov (academician RAS) and academician (RAS) Valentin Vitaljević Runjantsev. At their suggestion, she was also appointed as the first Scientific Secretary of the newly founded Branch of the Academy of Nonlinear Sciences from Moscow, in Belgrade. He is the organizer of the first Colloquium of the ANN Branch in Belgrade. He is a participant with scientific announcements in all three scientific meetings of the current SANN.

THE PROPOSAL

Based on the above, it can be clearly concluded that prof. Dr Ing Katica (Stevanović) Hedrih is among the most meritorious Serbian scientists in the field of nonlinear mechanics, who fought for world recognition and who made a significant contribution to the development of the Serbian Academy of Nonlinear Sciences.
