On behalf of the Congress Committee of IUTAM, I am happy to inform you that your paper with ICTAM08ID 10135 entitled

***PHENOMENOLOGICAL MAPPING METHOD AND MATHEMATICAL ANALOGY OF HUBRID SYSTEM DYNAMICS***

has been accepted for presentation at the 22<sup>nd</sup> International Congress of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics (ICTAM2008), provisionally allocated in the Seminar Session: **SM19 Structural vibrations**.

IUTAM congresses are held only every four years and are the leading scientific events in the field of Mechanics. We received 1517 contributed submissions of the Congress of which only 1323 were accepted, clearly identifying ICTAM2008 as one of the most selective mechanics conferences in the world. At this time we request that you confirm your intention to participate by logging in to the Congress web site <http://ictam2008.adelaide.edu.au/login.php> and completing the form now available under 'Attendance details' in your account menu: <http://ictam2008.adelaide.edu.au/attendance.php>.

The School of Mathematical Sciences, The University of Adelaide, will publish the abstract and the extended summary of your lecture in the ICTAM2008 Abstract Book and CD-ROM Proceedings. This volume will be available at the Congress. It may be referenced as ISBN 978-0-9805142-0-9, with 2008 as the year of publication. In order to schedule your presentation in the program and include your abstract in the Abstract Book and CD-ROM Proceedings, you must submit the above information by **30 May 2008**, and pay the registration fee by **25 July 2008**. As we explained in the final announcement **27 June 2008** is the last day to take advantage of the early bird registration fee.

The seminar presentations have two components: a brief oral overview of the work in one of several chaired parallel sessions (**3 minutes maximum, 2 overheads**), and a full display of your work in a large room. You will find instructions for preparing your presentation on the Congress web site.

The day and time for the presentation will be stated in the Final Program that you will receive as part of your registration materials at the Congress Registration Desk and will be posted on the Congress web site after **8 August 2008**. I congratulate you on the acceptance of your paper and look forward to seeing you in Adelaide.
