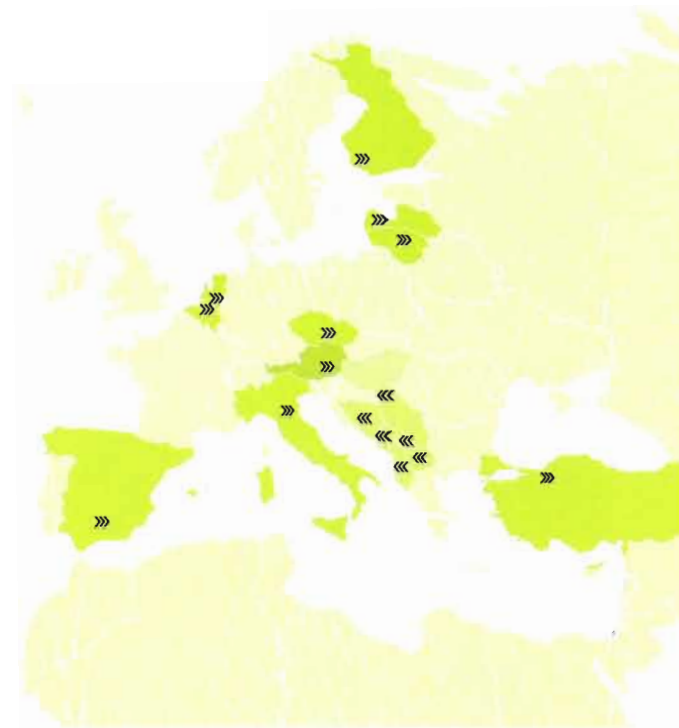

## Aims of JoinEU-SEE

- to strengthen the academic as well as the political, cultural and economic co-operation between the EU & Candidate countries and Western Balkan countries in order to enhance a vision of a united Europe
- to enhance the international co-operation capacity of Western Balkan universities by sharing good practice and knowledge in the organization of mobility programmes for students and staff for the purpose of studying, joint teaching, training and research, and the transfer of know-how and innovation
- to increase the academic competences, the language skills as well as social and intercultural competences of students and staff participating in the programme in order to improve the employability of students and scientific staff in the EU & Candidate countries and in Western Balkan countries

## Who can apply?

Students and staff members of all partner universities, both from the Western Balkan countries and EU & Candidate countries, as well as other Nationals of Western Balkan countries, can apply for scholarships.

## Types of scholarships and duration

Level of mobility	Duration	Allowance
Undergraduate	6 or 10 months	1,000 € per month
Master	6, 10 or 22 months	1,000 € per month
Doctorate	6, 10 or 22 months	1,500€ per month
Post-doctorate	6 months	1,800 € per month
Staff	1 month	2,500 € per month

The scholarship includes a monthly allowance (see above), tuition fee (where applicable), a flight ticket and medical insurance.

## Fields of Study

All universities in the JoinEU-SEE consortium are comprehensive universities that offer a wide range of studies which are open to participants of the exchange programmes. At the same time, the academic needs and special offers of universities are taken as the basis for the mobility frame.

### Target Group I

### Target Group II

- Nationals of Western Balkan countries registered at a higher education institution in one of the 6 Western Balkan partner countries not included in the JoinEU-SEE network or
- Nationals of Western Balkan countries having obtained a university degree or equivalent at an institution in a Western Balkan partner country. This includes the possibility of providing mobility opportunities to graduates already working in public administration, public and private enterprises

### Target Group III

Nationals of Western Balkan countries registered at a higher education institution in Western Balkan partner countries or holders of a university degree or equivalent from an institution in a Western Balkan partner country belonging to disadvantaged groups:

- ethnic minorities
- refugees
- asylum seekers
- economically disadvantaged persons
- disabled persons
